CLIMATE CHANGE STATEMENT

Telscombe Town Council recognises:

The overwhelming weight of scientific evidence which establishes the risk of man-made climate change and the implications for global warming leading to rising sea levels; loss of habitat; loss of bio-diversity and the associated long-term dangers to human and all other life on the planet

AND

The Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change Report on Global Warming in October 2018, which described the harm that a 2C rise in global temperatures is likely to cause and which advised that limiting global warming to 1.5C may be possible with ambitious action from national and sub-national authorities, civil society and the private sector

AND RESOLVES WITH IMMEDIATE EFFECT

To engage with local residents, businesses, schools and other sectors of our community to take appropriate steps to seek commitments at all levels to work towards carbon neutrality and environmental sustainability by 2030.
