School Summer Holiday Activities

Lewes District Council have recently agreed a new scheme for recycling 'One Bin Chuck It All In', whereby all recycling can be placed in one bin.

The large wheelie bins will be provided by Lewes District Council. This area will be the first to use the scheme later in the year before its ultimately rolled out across the District.

Walkers Return

Permission for a temporary footpath diversion round the Southern Water site was granted in 1971 while excavation of a section of cliff was undertaken. In the absence of a formal diversion, the footpath should have been reinstated on completion of the excavation but this didn't happen and the footpath has remained closed for 45 years. With thanks to lots of campaigning by the Ramblers Association, the Telscombe Residents Association and Telscombe Town Council, a permanent diverted footpath has now been established across the site, meaning walkers can now stroll from Saltdean to Newhaven along the cliff tops without having to go roadside.



Armed Forces Day

Armed Forces Day is a chance to show support for the men and women who make up the Armed Forces community: from currently serving troops to Service families, veterans and cadets. Telscombe Town Council did this by raising the Armed Forces Day Flag at the Civic Centre for the week leading up to the actual day.





We were honoured to have our Freewoman, Brenda Sawyers, raise the flag for us which was preceded by a minutes silence for the victims of the Grenfell fire in London a few days before.



Consultation on Public Spaces Protection Orders

We would like to hear from residents and organisations about our proposals to introduce new Public Spaces Protection Orders (PSPOs) to Lewes town and Lewes district.

PSPOs are something councils can put in place to protect the community from antisocial behaviour. They put conditions or restrictions on what people can do within a specific area if there is evidence to suggest that a problem exists.

We have reviewed our existing orders and are proposing to establish PSPOs covering:

- · dog fouling on public land anywhere in Lewes district, and
- the drinking of alcohol in public in Lewes town.

Under the proposals, anyone found not to be clearing up after their dog may face a fine of up to £1,000 and anyone failing to stop drinking or surrender alcohol when asked to do so by an authorised officer may receive a fine of up to £500.

Lewes District Council are currently holding a consultation regarding Public Spaces Protection Orders across the Lewes District - see information above. With this in mind, Telscombe Town Council is starting to explore whether such an order may be possible to apply locally to help prevent dog worrying and protect the community flock. Please do undertake the consultation above so that opinions can be engaged.
