Girls get their hands dirty with arts and crafts, get in touch with nature and play games - it's all about learning by doing. Being a Rainbow is all about having the space to try new things. Through taking part in a range of different activities with girls their own age, Rainbows develop self-confidence and make lots of new friends.

Rainbows learn and grow through a programme of age-appropriate activities, trips and adventures - both in their regular meetings and at special events. They can work towards interest badges, where they can learn about everything from recycling to storytelling and start their skills builder journey, developing core skills and trying new things like camping, leadership and first aid.






