Homeridge Gardening Group has only recently been formed by residents at Homeridge House, an independent living retirement development in Saltdean. The Group has a Committee with Chairperson, Secretary and joint-Treasurers. A Constitution has been adopted and a bank account has been opened with Lloyds bank.

Therefore having only just formed there are no yearly accounts to submit. However we were advised by Angela Greenfield to apply for a grant and explain why no accounts are available.

The aims of the Group include the following:

- Provide opportunity for residents to enhance their health and wellbeing through outdoor activity.
- Undertake gardening tasks to enhance the grounds for the pleasure of residents.
- Bring those residents who have previously enjoyed having a garden together in a gardening themed social environment.
- Arrange group visits to garden centres and gardens near and far.

Certain parts of the gardens at Homeridge House are in need of a makeover and any donation will go towards purchasing plants, compost for shrub beds, garden furniture, any hand tools needed, sacks for collecting garden rubbish, PPE where needed. Also towards the cost of stationery for printing notices, membership forms and copies of the Constitution for all members etc.

In addition, the Group have received permission from the managing agent for a solar powered water fountain in the Patio Garden Project and the planting of two trees to commemorate the life of Queen Elizabeth II and the coronation of King Charles III. The Patio Garden Project consists of forming a hedge of wind and salt tolerant shrubs to keep the south-westerlies at bay, enabling residents to sit comfortably in the garden, and an environment tolerable to smaller shrubs and plants.

There are around 85 residents at Homeridge House and very many are unable to physically take on any gardening tasks. We have 9 active volunteers so far (very early days) and several 'non-active' residents who like to come and watch us working and have a chat.

It is very difficult to name an amount of grant to request. Any amount would be very gratefully received and spent appropriately and transparently. Some towards the stationery or for the purchase of the water fountain (£199.99 and could be named in your honour)? I repeat, we would be extremely grateful for ANY grant.

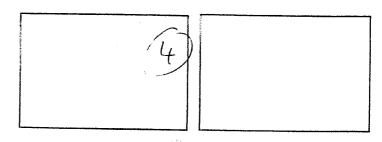
